

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, the County Clerk be and is hereby instructed to release warrants in Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12 in the amount of \$4,000 payable to the Amulco Products Company in payment of partial estimate on the reconstruction of the paving of 65th West Avenue over the Black Boy Diversion Channel. Dear Sir:

Replying to the reference letter, please be advised that it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners, acting for the Tulsa County Drainage District No. 13, that a storm water pump station at the southwest corner of the town of Jenks, adjacent to the proposed ponding area, is sound and economical, and is necessary that the station be provided in the final plans. This station would prevent the flooding of homes and property between elevation 609.0 and elevation 611.0 from all but the storm of greatest intensity (1940). It would further allow the District to hold the ponding area to smaller dimensions during all storms, thus reducing damage and small ponds that might be breeding places for mosquitos.

Regarding the installation of the pumping plant on the sanitary sewer near the southeast corner of Jenks, the District feels that this would contribute greatly to the prevention of the outbreak of disease and property damage which would be caused by the overflow of sewage through the main lines in the town during the time the Arkansas River is flooded.

We, the Board of County Commissioners, acting for Drainage District No. 13, respectfully request that these stations be provided in the final plan, and it is understood that the District would be required to maintain these stations, and also, provide for the installation of power lines to the Station.

Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
