Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the petition filed re Parkview Drainage Ditch be accepted and filed and that the County Engineer be instructed to authorize the Ditch Commissioners to submit an estimate as to cost of doing the work set out in said petition. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

A Petition of the Public Service Company of Oklahoma for right of way on highways was filed. Thereupon Commissioner Morley offers the following resolution and moved its adoption:

"WHEREAS, the Public Service Company of Oklahoma, has requested the Board of County Commissioners to grant permission to said County to establish pole lines carrying cross arms and electric wires for the transmission of electric current along the streets, alleys and easements of the following additions in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

Third Crestview Estates
Jefferson Terrace

and

WHEREAS, it appears that said petition should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, permission be, and the same is hereby given the Public Service Company of Oklahoma to construct, operate and maintain a pole line with cross arms and wires for the transmission of electric current on the public highways above described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said pole line be constructed in a substantial manner and properly maintained at the border of said highways, or near the curb line of the streets, or near the properly line of the alleys in such manner as not to interfere with public travel or the use of said highways, streets or alleys."

Which motion is seconded, voted upon with the following result:

Thereupon, it is ascertained that said resolution has received the unanimous vote of all commissioners, and is declared duly adopted and it is so ordered.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the application for assistance in pond construction filed by J. R. Caudle, Jr., and approved by O. J. Moyer, County Agent, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
