Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that Andy Stokes, County Clerk, be instructed to prepare a financial statement of the General Fund as at the close of business June 20th, 1942, in connection with a supplemental appropriation. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the District Court, for the month of May, 1942, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that Bernard Goodall, Deputy State Examiner & Inspector, be instructed to prepare the budget for Tulsa County for the fiscal year 1942-1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the Restricted County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$4,003.79, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
