The following letter was directed to all drug stores, undertakers, hospitals and physicians doing business with Tulsa County; also Dr. T. R. Roberts, Dr. T. W. Stalling and Mr. S. P. Kenton:

Gentlemen:

You are hereby notified that the funds appropriated for the County of Tulsa, for charitable purposes for the fiscal year 1934-35 have been exhausted. At the present time there are no funds available for the payment of bills for drugs, ambulance service, undertaker service, physician service, hospitalization, etc., to charity patients from Jan. 7th to June 30th, 1935, the end of the fiscal year. The Board of County Commissioners is unable to say whether any plan can be worked out by which such bills can be paid.

Much as we regret it, we are compelled to advise you that the Board of County Commissioners, and the members of the board individually assume no responsibility for the payment of such bills from Jan. 7th to June 30th, 1935, and if such service is rendered or supplies sold for the use of charity patients or for hospitalization or physician service, will necessarily be rendered at the risk of those furnishing same and on an open account and at their own risk of being able in any way to collect same.
