Dear Mr. Brown:

There is a strong sentiment among Tulsa County farmers
 and farm leaders to move the County Agent offices from the
 Federal Building to the Tulsa State Fairgrounds. The farmers
 complaint of parking difficulties in downtown Tulsa. They al-
 so prefer to have the various farm agencies located close to-
 gether. At least one of these other agencies has moved to the
 Fairgrounds. The Fair Board is willing to provide suitable
 space for the County Agent offices, under arrangements to be
 made.

Knowing your reluctance to release free quarters in the
 Federal Building, we wish to assure you that we will see that the
 County Agent offices are properly housed, if the workers decide
 to leave their present location in order to serve the people
 of the County better. We will in that event, accept the re-
 sponsibility of providing office quarters, utilities, janitor
 service and office equipment now furnished them at the Federal
 Building, insofar as we are authorized and empowered so to do.
