The farmers complaint of parking difficulties in downtown Tulsa. They also prefer to have the various farm agencies located close together. At least one of these other agencies has moved to the Fairgrounds. The Fair Board is willing to provide suitable space for the County Agent offices, under arrangements to be made.

Knowing your reluctance to release free quarters in the Federal Building, we wish to assure you that we will see that the County Agent offices are properly housed, if the workers decide to leave their present location in order to serve the people of the County better. We will in that event, accept the responsibility of providing office quarters, utilities, janitor service and office equipment now furnished them at the Federal Building, insofar as we are authorized and empowered so to do.
