Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., with all members present and presiding as before.

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF CONSTRUCTING A GRADE SEPARATION AT THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE MIDLAND VALLEY RAILROAD WHERE RIVERSIDE DRIVE BOULEVARD EXTENDING FROM TWENTY SEVENTH PLACE, ALONG AND PARALLEL TO THE NORTH BANK OF THE ARKANSAS RIVER ON THE WESTERLY LINE OF ROVERSIDE TERRANCE ADDITION. INTERSECTS SAID RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CITY OF TULSA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO COOPERATE WITH THE CITY ENGINEER AND PREPARE THE NECESSARY PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATED COSTS OF A GRADE SEPARATION, APPROACHES THERETO AND THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF, ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY THEREFOR, AND PRESENT THE SAME TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SAID FUNDS.
