Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Bond made by Paul A. Wilson and Wade L. Reynolds in the sum of \$100.00 to cover cost in the vacating of Twenty-Second Street from the east line of Florence St., to the East line of Wilshire Manor, be and the same is hereby cancelled, the requirements of said bond having been fulfilled and there being no further necessity of said bond. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
