R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, The Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma has held, as this Board has been informed, that Bills of the Character of Senate Bill No. 113, same being Chapter 51, of the Session Laws of 1923, are unconstitutional and invalid, for the reason that such laws were local in their nature and application, and were passed as General Laws, and

WHEREAS, in view of said Supreme Court decision, this Board is doubtful of its authority to pay the salaries and expenses incurred in the operation of the Court of Common Pleas created under said Senate Bill.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this Board do hereby express to the Members of the Legislature of Tulsa County their opinion that said Senate Bill No. 113 should be repealed and respectfully request the Members of the Legislature, representing this County, to prepare and submit a bill for the repealing of said Senate Bill No. 113, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a true and correct copy of this Resolution be transmitted to each member of the Legislature representing Tulsa County.
