MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION WORK BETWEEN TULSA COUNTY AND THE OKLAHOMA AGRICULATURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE EXTENSION DIVISION, IN CO-OPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULATURE.

OBJECT:

For the purpose of assisting the farmers of this County with their many problems of soil fertility, terracing, economic crop production, livestock breeding, feeding and management, the prevention and control of crop diseases and insect pests, and the prevention and control of livestock diseases, thru educational means, also their problems of grading, standardizing and marketing their farm products, the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College proposes to establish in co-operation with the County, a direct service which shall bring the benefits of the A & M College, the State Experiment Stations, and the United States Department of Agriculture to the farmers of this County, and for the purpose of encouraging farmers and their families to make the best of all available opportunities, and for the particular encouragement of boys' and girls' club work.

TERM OF

The said Tulsa County Agrees to co-operate with the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agriculatural and Mechanical College and the United States

Department of Agriculture in conducting Agricultural and Home Economics

Extension work in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, during the year beginning July 1, 1927 and ending June 30, 1928.

METHOD OF PROCEDURE

For the objects expressed above, the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, co-operating with the United States Department of Agriculture shall select the agent or agents to be employed, such persons to be well qualified to fill these positions by training, education and experience, who shall be satisfactory to the Commissioners of the saidnCounty.

COUNTY FUNDS AND EQUIPMENT

The County Commissioners agree to pay Twenty Seven Hundred Dollars (\$2700) per year on the salary of a County Agricultural Agent, and Fourteen Hundred Forty Dollars (\$1440.) per year on the salar y of a County Home Demonstration Agent for a period of Twelve months beginning July 1st. 1927. The County Commissioners further agree to furnish an office and to appropriate the following amounts to apply on the expenses of the County Agent; for the
