2 In the matter of the Petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, the following Order was made:

#### O R D E R.

NOW, On this the 18th. day of November, 1929, the matter of the Petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows:, to-wit:

Crossing East and West Highway between the Southwest Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section One (1) and the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Twelve (12), and along the South side of Highway between Sections one (1) and Twelve (12), Township Nineteen (19), North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and between Sections Six (6) and Seven (7), Five (5) and Eight (8), Four and Nine (9) Three (3) and Ten (10) Two (2) and Eleven (11), all in Township Nineteen (19), North, Range Fourteen (14), East; a twelve (12) inch gas pipe line located according to blue print hereto attached and made a part hereof, and known as Line CM-38.

AND, it further appearing from the Petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
