WHEREAS, the limits of the City extend to only the center line of said railroad right of way; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa desires to cooperate with the County of Tulsa in completing and extending the said highway to the intersection with the Sapulpa Highway on U.S. Highway No. 66, and to bear its pro-rata share of the cost thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable at this time for the best interest of Tulsa County that said plans and specifications be prepared and approved to that said work can be constructed that at the time the County Commissioners deem it advisable to request an appropriation therefor and when same is approved by the Excise Board, provided however the Board of County Commissioners shall be the sole judges as to when funds are so available for the completion of said work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be necessary to construct a grade separation where the heavy traffic way extending from a point on Quannah Avenue at or near the present Eleventh Street Bridge over the Arkansas River in West Tulsa intersects the rights of way of the Sapulpa Union and Midland Valley Railroads in the City of Tulsa and acquire additional rights of way and approaches thereto.

Section 2. That said grade separation be constructed in conjunction with the City of Tulsa and the County Engineer be and he is hereby instructed to prepare the necessary plans, specifications and costs of said grade separation in conjunction with the City Engineer of the City of Tulsa and submit same to this Board within a reasonable time.

Section 3. That the portion of the cost of constructing said grade separation, the approach thereto, and the additional rights of way necessary therefor within the corporate limits of said City to be borne by said City.

Section 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

O R D E R

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to J. G. WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said lots, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said lots for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled and pursuant to the aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property so made by the County Treasurer to J. G. AND L. C. BREWER for a consideration of \$25.00, and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to J. G. AND L. C. BREWER a deed conveying to him all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.
