Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the proposal, plans and specifications for the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done for the improvement and paving of Apache Street from Peoria Avenue to Sheridan Road, a distance of 3.93 miles at an estimated cost of \$136,639.75, be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to advertise for bids to be received until 9 o'clock A.M., July 6th, 1942, said advertisement to be given to the Newspaper Printing Corporation and to run for two consecutive weeks. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the application for additional and supplemental appropriations for the General Fund in the amount of \$11,880.34, be and the same is hereby approved and ordered submitted to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that a recess be taken until 3:00 o'clock P.M. Motion carried.

Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
