# O R D E R.

Now, on this 2nd. day of February, 1925, the above entitled matter came before the Board of County Commissioners, seeking its order as provided for by Sec. 4749 C.O.S. 1921, and it having been made to appear to said Board of County Commissioners in the hearing of the application therefor, that the survey, map and census provided for by law has been sufficiently shown by affidavits, and it appearing that said map, survey and census were subject to examination in the manner and for the period of time as in said section provided.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED By the Board of County Commissioners in regular meeting assembled that the territory, as shown upon said map and survey shall with the assent of the qualified voters of said territory be an incorporated town by the manner specified in the application aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that the qualified voters, resident in said proposed town, shall assemble in meeting at some convenient place therein, to-wit: Feb. 16, 1925, on a certain day, within one month from this date to determine whether such territory shall be an incorporated Town.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the notice of said meeting as provided for by Sec. C O S 1921, make specific reference to certain outstanding bonded indebtedness, affecting said territory, which must be assumed proportionately in the event it shall be determined such territory shall be an Incorporated Town.
