RESOLUTION VACATING AND CLOSING PROPOSED ROAD.

Now on this 10th day of March, 1941, there comes on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, the petition of more than twelve freeholders residing in the vicinity of the road affected, which petition prays that a proposed road be vacated, set aside and closed on the following described route, to-wit:

The Easterly 25 Feet of the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 20, Township 20, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And it appearing that said petition is in all respects sufficient; that said proposed road is outside the city limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and that said road is unnecessary and impractical; that said land has never been used by the public as a public way, and that there is no public necessity for said road.

Be it resolved by the County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, sitting in regular session, that the said road above described and the dedication of road upon the land above described be vacated, set aside and closed, all as set out in said petition to vacate.
