The Board of County Commissioners met in an adjourned session in the usual place in the Tulsa County Court House at 2 P. M. Present:- F. M. Wooden, Chairman W. L. North, V. Chairman, Ed Dalton, Member, and Lewis Cline, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, after which the business proceeded in general order.

The first business coming before the Board for hearing was the petition to open roadway on the half section line in Section Four (4), Township Nineteen (19) Range Thirteen (13). There being present C. H. Overton, J. C. Whiteside, M. C. Cory and Mr. Dunn, petitioners, the other side being represented by J. C. Berger. The advisability of the opening of this roadway was taken up and duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners, and on motion of W. L. North seconded by Ed Dalton a fifty (50) foot road way was granted on the half section line in 4-19-13 when deeds are filed for said roadway.
