

January 18th, 1935.

FIRST: That certain appropriations heretofore made are inadequate to properly maintain the GENERAL FUND of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the current fiscal year, and that the public welfare and needs of said County are such as to require for the remainder of said year, for legal and ordinary expenses, the additional appropriations as listed and set forth by purposes and amounts in Exhibit "A" attached, and made a part hereof.

SECOND: That the Financial Statement hereto attached and marked Exhibit "B" shows as of the close of the month next preceeding the filing hereof the true and correct condition of the GENERAL FUND of said municipality, and the surplus of \$8,653.48 thereon shown is available for additional appropriations.

THIRD: That on December 31, 1934, there was on hand in the office of the County Treasurer of said County to the credit of the GENERAL FUND unappropriated cash in the amount of \$695.80 derived from fees collected from patients at the Colored Municipal hospital, and said amount is subject to be appropriated for current expenses purposes in the GENERAL FUND for the remainder of the current fiscal year.

WHEREFORE, request is hereby made that the surplus existing in the GENERAL FUND for the fiscal years 1930-31 and back in the amount of \$8,653.48 and said unappropriated cash in the amount of \$695.80, and a total amount of \$9,349.28 be appropriated for the several additional and supplemental purposes as set forth in Exhibit "A" hereof.

WE FURTHER CERTIFY, that the aggregate amount of said proposes additional and supplemental appropriations is not in excess of the income and revenue provided and accumulated for the current year.
