This being an adjourned session from September 2nd, 1919. F. M. Wooden, Chairman, W. L. North, V. Chairman, Ed Dalton, member, and Lewis Cline County Clerk and Clerk of the Board, all being present and meeting in the usual place in the Tulsa County Court House, at 2 o'clock P. M. on this 3rd day of September 1919.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the Seneca Coal Company be restrained from keeping up or operating said coal mines on the section line between Sections 21 and 22, Township 22 North, Range, 14 East. Said motion prevailing.

A motion was made by Ed Dalton and seconded by W. L. North that the petition of the Oklahoma Gas and Electric ompany come up for hearing and consideration by the Board of County Commissioners on the 15th day of September, 1919. Passed.

On motion of W. L. North which motion was seconded by EdDalton the Pierce Oil Copporation was given a permit to construct a 6 inch gas line from the Refinery of the Pierce Oil Corporation at Sand Sapings, Oklahoma, to a certain point in Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 11 East a total distance of three (3) miles more or less, along sections 13 and 14m and 23 and 24 and 25 and 26 in said Township 19 North, Range 11 East, it being understood that in the event it becomes necessary to open this road as a public highway said Pierce Oil Corporation will immediately and without delay move said line at the expense of the said Pierce Oil Corporation so as not to interfere with the road work in said Tulsa County.

The application of the Public Service Company of Oklahoma for leave to string and erect wires for the transmission of electricity over and across the Tulsa County Bridge located between Tulsa and West Tulsa, Oklahoma, spanning the Arkansas River was filed with, duly condidered and approved by the Board of County Commissioners on the third day of September, 1919.

There being no further business coming before the Board of County Commissioners for condicration at this segsion, on motion duly made and seconded said Board adjourned to meet in their next regular session on the 15th day of September, 1919.
