In the matter of the Petition of one George S Bole, for permission to lay a six inch water pipe line along and under certain highways, the following order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, On this 18 day of July, 1927, the matter of the petition of George S. Bole for permission to lay a six inch water pipe line along and under certain highways in said County and State, came before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said George S. Bole be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by the hereinafter description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Forty Fifth Street and Lewis Road, and extending West along the South side of 41st. a distance of 1800 feet; said water line to extend along the North Line of Section 30, Township 19, North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be constructed under the rules and regulations and supervision of the City Water Department of the City of Tulsa, and will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways, and also will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Okla. governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to the said George S. Bole his heirs and assigns, to use as much of the highway as above designated for the purpose of constructing said water line.
