

Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on North Greenwood Avenue near the intersection of Haskell Street, -- The main line to run North along Greenwood Ave. to what is known as the Section Line of Pine Street in -- Then east to Lansing and Peoria Avenues -- Then South on Lansing and Peoria Avenues to the incorporated limits of the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and North on Lansing and Peoria Ave as far as the colored population goes, and to include all intersecting streets running East and West beginning two blocks west of Greenwood Ave., running as far East as Peoria Ave.

The Poles and wires of said lines to be located so as not to interfere with the full use and enjoyment of the highways by the public and so as not to interfere with working or repairing said highways; and also that all wires and poles be located so as not to interfere with the rights of property owners along that portion of the public highways traversed by said telephone lines, leaving unobstructed by wires or poles all ways of ingress and egress.

Wooden, seconded by Ita Short, that the request of the North Greenwood Telephone Company be granted but that the work of construction must be done under the supervision of the County Engineer. The vote on the motion was as follows: Wooden - Yes, Short - Yes, Geo.E. Gilmore Yes. Motion was declared carried.

R E S O L U T I O N .

WHEREAS, Cosden & Company, a corporation, is the owner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, a public highway, known as Gusher Avenue, runs along the eastern line of the above described real estate and premises; and,

WHEREAS, the eastern half of the aforesaid highway is situated in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, but the western half of said highway is not in any incorporated town or city, but is situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, The said Cosden & Company purposes to erect certain buildings, structures and other improvements upon its aforesaid property; and

WHEREAS, According to the plans for the aforesaid buildings, structures and other improvements, certain hereinafter described portions of the bases or foundations thereof and therefor will extend beyond the eastern line of the aforesaid property of the said Cosden & Company, and out into the western half of the aforesaid Gusher Avenue, to-wit: That according to the aforesaid plans, among other things, the said Cosden & Company purposes to erect a certain boiler house, to be known as Boiler House No. 4, near the eastern line of its above described property, and that along the eastern line of said building there will be seven (7) concrete pilaster bases and that a portion of each of said bases, 6 feet long and 1-1/2 inches wide, will extend beyond the eastern line of the property of said Cosden & Company and out into the western half of the said Gusher Avenue; and that according to the aforesaid plans, among other things, the said Cosden & Company purposes to erect a certain chimney shaft near the eastern line of its above described property, and that the base of said chimney shaft will be constructed of concrete, and that a portion of said base, approximately 25 feet and 1 inch long, and 5-1/2 feet wide, will extend beyond the eastern line of the property of said Cosden & Company, and out into the western half of the said Gusher Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the said Cosden & Company desires to obtain the right, power and authority to excavate so much of the western half of the said Gusher Avenue as is necessary to lay and construct the aforesaid seven (7) concrete pilaster bases, and to lay and construct the aforesaid concrete base for the aforesaid chimney shaft, all as aforesaid, and to lay, erect and construct said pilaster bases and the said chimney base, as above mentioned and described and to permanently maintain the same; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma is of the opinion that the said Cosden & Company should be granted such right, power and authority;

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the said Cosden & Company, be, and it is hereby granted the right power and authority to excavate so much of the western half of said Gusher Avenue as is necessary to lay and construct the aforesaid seven (7) concrete pilaster bases and to lay and construct the aforesaid concrete base for the aforesaid chimney shaft all as aforesaid, and the lay, erect and construct said pilaster bases and said chimney shaft base, as above mentioned and described, and to permanently maintain the same: PROVIDED, However, that the top surface of each of the aforesaid pilaster bases and the top surface of the aforesaid chimney shaft base shall not be less than three (3) feet below the grade line of the aforesaid Gusher Avenue; and PROVIDED Further that immediately after the completion of the said pilaster bases and said chimney shaft base, the said Gusher Avenue shall be restored by the said Cosden & Company, at its own cost and expense, to substantially the same condition the same was in before the commencement of work upon said pilaster bases and said chimney shaft base.
