Motion was made by Mr. North, that the Clerk be instructed to transfer from Account No. 4, Division No. 2, the sum of Nine Thousand Dollars, (\$9,000.00) to Account No. 4, Division No. 1. Motion seconded by Mr. Bohnefeld, and declared carried.

The following Resolution was introduced by Mr. North, who moved its adoption, motion to adopt was seconded by Mr. Bohnefeld, and the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Under Senate Bill No. 44 of the Extraordinary Session of the Ninth Oklahoma Legislature, the hereinafter described highway was designated as a part of the County Highway System,

AND, WHEREAS, it is now deemed to be to the best interest of the Road System of Tulsa County that the said mile be abandoned as a County Highway

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That

"The Section line between Sections Twenty Two (22) and Twenty Three (23), Township Nineteen (19), North, Range Eleven (11) East, same being Mile One (1) of Section "A-2" according to the official map of Tulsa County"

be abandoned as a County Highway and turned back into the Township Road System of Red Fork Township.

All members voting in the affirmative, the motion was declared carried and Resolution adopted.

The report of County Clerk for both Clerk's Department and Register of Deeds Department for the month of April, 1932, was received and ordered filed.
