

Thursday, October 9th, 1919.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma met in an adjourned session on the 9th day of October, 1919. Present in person, F. M. Wooden, Chairman, W. L. North, Commissioner and Ed Dalton Commissioner and Lewis Cline, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board.

The following Affidavits of Erroneous Assessment were ordered stricken from records by the Board of County Commissioners: G. D. Adsit, Marie Allison, Rachel McClane, W. B. Blair, and Tulsa Elks Club, and E. A. Lilly, Agt. for Ester Rhodes.

The application of the Sheriff's Office for a special deputy to look after Auto Licenses in the County of Tulsa, was disallowed by the Board of County commissioners.

The Official Bond of Dr. Mont V. Stanley as County Physician was filed and approved also the bonds of William Sanders and J. T. Wilmot as Road Supervisors were filed and approved.

The following appointments were made in the Sheriff's Office:- N. H. Langley, Deputy Sheriff, W. S. Mayfield, Deputy Sheriff, H. H. Dobson, Deputy Sheriff, W. T. Kithcart, Deputy Sheriff, Ed Harn, Deputy Sheriff, James Foutz, Special Deputy, J. H. Smitherman, Deputy Sheriff.

The following appointments by James Woolley, Sheriff, were disallowed by the Board of County Commissioners due to the fact that the law does not permit such deputies: Fay W. Warren, Deputy Sheriff, Dollie Boatright, Book-keeper, Ella M. Catter, Stenographer, Barney Cleaver, Deputy Sheriff and Stalie Webb, Deputy Sheriff.

A motion was made by W. L. North, and seconded by Ed Dalton that the petition of Fleetweed, et al, for the opening of a road thru the center of Section 8, Township 19 North, Range 13 east, be referred to the County Engineer, and that he make a report to this body at its next regular meeting.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the County Engineer be instructed to notify the Mayor and the City Commissioners of the City of Tulsa to repair the approach to the Arkansas River Bridge in the City of Tulsa, said Commissioners allowing the Employees of the City of Tulsa to cut sewer ditch through said approach, thereby damaging same.

A Motion was made by Ed Dalton and seconded by W. L. North that the County Engineer be instructed to draw up plans and specifications for the Glenpool and East Lynn Lane Road to be let on November 3rd, 1919.

There being no further business coming before the Board at his meeting on motion of W. L. North said meeting adjourned to meet in its next regular session on Monday, October 20th, 1919.
