Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the names of Morris L. Bradford and Mike Ledbetter submitted by Frank Markham be approved as deputies in the Court of Common Pleas Court. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.
