Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the proposal, plans and specifications for the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done for the improvement and paving of 36th Street North from the paving in place West of Yale Avenue to Sheridan Road, a distance of 1.16 mile, at an estimated cost of \$43,712.80, be and the same are hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to advertise for bids to be received until 9'o'clock A.M., July 20th, 1942, said-advertisement to be given to the Newspaper Printing Corporation to run for two consecutive weeks. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the report filed by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, for the board of prisoners for the month of June, 1942, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that \$2,000 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries for the month of July, 1942. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the NYA sponsorship be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
