R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 9666, C O S 1921, it is the duty of the County Assessor of said County to begin on the 15th. day of January, 1930, the listing of all taxable property in said County, and assess the value thereof as of January 1st., of said year, and by posting notices at the time and in the manner and places as provided in said Section, and

WHEREAS, under said Section 9666 said Assessor is not authorized to proceed in the listing of such property by giving said notices until authorized by this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the County Assessor of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized to begin the listing all taxable property in said County, and assess the value thereof as of January 1st. 1930, by posting notices in three or more conspicuous places in each City or voting precinct in said County at least ten (10) days prior to the date such Assessor will meet the tax payers to list their property, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution be published at least once in some newspaper of general circulation in said County.

All voting in the affirmative motion was declared carried and the Resolution adopted.
