Proposals were submitted for the grading and culvert work of miles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Section "T", and miles 3 and 4 of section "U" of the Jenks - Glenpool road and Mile 6 of Section "I" and miles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Section "J" Lynn Lane Road. Joseph T. Lantry, Contractor, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and T. C. Ottinger, Contractor, Anadarko, Oklahoma, submitting proposals for consideration.

On final consideration of the proposals submitted a motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ed Dalton that Joseph T. RESOLDUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
