Proposals were submitted for the grading and culvert work of miles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Section "T", and miles 3 and 4 of section "U" of the Jenks - Glenpool road and Mile 6 of Section "I" and miles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of Section "J" Lynn Lane Road. Joseph T. Lantry, Contractor, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and T. C. Ottinger, Contractor, Anadarko, Oklahoma, submitting proposals for consideration.

On final consideration of the proposals submitted a motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ed Dalton that Joseph T. Lantry be awarded the contract for all culvert construction on both the Jenks-Glenpool and the Lynn Lane Roads. All members present voting in the affirmative. Said contractor to file bond with the Board of County Commissioners for the faithful performance of said work, and begin actual work within thirty (30) days from award of contract and complete said work within 180 working days from the date of the execution of the contract or pay to Tulsa County as liquidated damages the sum of \$10.00 per day thereafter, barring however, unavoidable causes beyond the control of said contractor.

The contract for all grading on both the Jenks-Glenpool and the Lynn Lane roads was, on motion of F. M. Wooden seconded by Ed Dalton was awarded T. C. Ottinger on the same terms and conditions as above set forth in the contract of Joseph T. Lantry.

RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The following resolution was presented by Ed Dalton who moved its adoption, and the same was duly seconded by F. M. Wooden.

Be it resolved that WHEREAS an emergency exists by reason of the unsafe and generally unsatisfactory condition of the floor on the Jenks Arkansas River Bridge.

AND WHEREAS funds are available for the reconstruction of such bridge floor, and lumber for the flooring is now in possession of Tulsa County,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to enter into a contract or an agreement with some reputable contractor to do and perform such work as is necessary in reflooring said bridge, and the furnishing of such additional material as is necessary on a force account basis at actual cost, plus not to exceed 15 % for contractors profit.
