In the matter of the application for correction of erroneous assessment  
Trustees of the  
filed by the/Former Stockholders of the Tulsa Building & Loan Association of Record on  
July 10, 1935, coming on for hearing. Testimony was heard. Mr. Ralph Darnell:  
The values as testified to by Arthur Newlin were placed on the properties by Mr. Newlin  
and myself. The properties two years ago were in a much worse state of repair than they  
are at the present time as the majority of the properties have been repaired and re-  
habilitated. Some of the properties inspected by Mr. Newlin and myself were in such  
a bad state of repair that we advised that the improvements be removed entirely. The  
reason Mr. Newlin and I made these inspections and appraisals two years ago was to  
establish the values on the properties; also to make recommendations as to what should  
be done.

Mr. King and Dr. Gorrell also testified as to the values of these properties.  
Mr. Milsten, Mr. Johnson and Mr. Ingle, also appearing for the Tulsa Building and Loan  
Association. Final action on the application is deferred until a later date.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the  
affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by J. M. Thorp covering Lots 11 and 12, Block 2,  
Elm Ridge Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the years 1933, 1934 and 1935, be  
and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a  
certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative,  
motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the  
affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by G. F. Claypool covering Lot 21, Block 12,  
Gillette Hall Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the years 1929, 1930, 1931  
and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to  
issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the  
affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the  
affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by F. Wayne Hancock covering the S. 25' of the  
N. 35' of Lot 6, Block 119, O.T. Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the years 1931, 1932, 1933 and  
1934, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to  
issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the  
affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the  
affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by E. C. Johnson, Agent for J. E. Nichols cover-  
ing realstate for the years 1930 to 1935, inc., be and the same is hereby approved and  
the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same.  
Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman  
declared carried.
