The official Bond of D. Lee as road supervisor for section "Y" of Wekiwa Township was filed and approved by this Board.

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ed Dalton that Lewis Cline, County Clerk, be authorized to enter into a contract with J. M. Springer for the rental of the east cattle barn on the free fair grounds, for a term of three months at a rental of \$20.00 per month, providing however, that the said J. M. Springer shall not operate and maintain a dairy while in said location. Thereupon said motion was voted upon and by the chairman declared duly carried, and ordered spread upon the minutes.

The clerk announced that the petition of W. M. Fleetwood, et al, for the opening of a roadway thru the center of section 8, township 19 north, Range 13, east which road would be a continuation of Terrace Drive on 15th street, was before the Board. It was noted however that said petition bears the following notation from the County Engineer. "Approved, Subject however, that County will not be expected to do any work upon this road during the year 1919-20, on account of insufficiency of funds. Dan W. Patton, Co. Engr., 10-27-19" Thereupon a motion was made by Ed Dalton and seconded by F. M. Wooden that said roadway be opened providing however that said property owners deed a right of way of 60 feet to Tulsa County, and providing further that said petitioners grade and place same in-shape for public travel. All members present voting in the affirmative.

The petition for the improvement of the section line between sections 19 and 30 township 21 north, range 14 east, just north of Owasso Lake was referred to the county Engineer for approval.

The Pelligreen Construction and Investment company submitted the following proposal for the erection and completion of a new partition and the placing of the necessary equipment in the District Court Room in the Tulsa County Court House:
