R E S O L U T I O N.

WHEREAS, the Tenth Legislature passed an Act permitting Counties and Municipalities to be garnisheed in civil actions where employees of a County or any Municipality therein are alleged to be indebted to persons, firms and corporations, and

WHEREAS, This act will place upon the Counties, in response to Garnishment Summons, additional labor and expense.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That all employees of Tulsa County be and they are hereby notified that this Board shall expect that they pay and discharge their obligations at the time same becomes due, and in the event that any employee fails, refuses or neglects so to do and Tulsa County is garnisheed by reason of such failure and neglect to pay its debts, this Board will request the officer in charge of the Department in which any employee so failing to discharge his obligations to discharge such employee.
