It is hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, sitting in regular session this 15th day of July, 1942, that said above County roads and rights-of-way are hereby ordered temporarily closed and vacated and it is further ordered that there be opened and maintained a temporary detour running north and south on road that will be temporarily vacated and closed and to build 50 foot gravel all-weather road and to maintain same and keep in good condition as long as hauling equipment of The Seneca Coal & Coke Company is being used over said road which is one mile south of Oklahoma State Highway for one mile, said road being road running on county line between Tulsa and Wagoner County, Oklahoma, and upon reopening of said roads to put them in as good condition as the above roads are at this time.
