

MONDAY, JULY 20th, 1942.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, July 20th, 1942, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

This being the day set for the opening of the bids for the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done for the improvement and paving of 36th Street North from the paving in place west of Yale Ave., to Sheridan Road, a distance of 1.16 mile. The bids were as follows:

Layman Construction Company	\$44,042.76
Standard Paving Company	43,552.80

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the bids be referred to the County Engineer and Consulting Engineer for compilation and recommendation. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that, upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, J. W. Jackson of Broken Arrow; J. N. Patterson of Collinsville and R. E. Hunter of Bixby be employed as Inspectors on road projects now under construction at a salary of \$165.00 per month each, effective July 1st, 1942, they to furnish own transportation, including gasoline. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the summarized financial report of water improvement district No. 3 from Nov. 5, 1941 to February 5, 1942; and the summarized financial report of water improvement district No. 3 from February 5, 1942 to May 5, 1942, be and the same are hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
