Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Lease Contract between Galion Iron Works & Mfg. Co., and the Board of County Commissioners covering the leasing of 1 Galion No. 101 Tandem Drive, Diesel Motor Grader, Model G-23564-A, Serial M-2670, Motor UDF-249452I, EOA-2265, be approved. This contract is in the amount of \$350.00 per month and is effective until the 30th day of June, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that at the request of Mrs. Alwilda M. Bole, Owher of the Bolewood Acres, that certain county roads in said addition be temporarily closed until such time as the Commission orders otherwise, be granted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the recommendation of J. M. Baker, Ditch Commissioner of Parkview Drainage District #2, be approved. Said recommendation requested that the \$8,000 previously authorized by the Commission be placed on the tax rolls, and this money be used in cleaning out the Parkview Drainage Ditch. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the Abstractor's Bond of the Guaranty Abstract Company in the amount of \$10,000 and made by the National Surety Corporation, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
