Party of the second part agrees to perform all the work between he hours of 5 o'clock P.M. and 7 O'clock A. M. on week days and to so perform and construct the work that the bridge will be open for traffic between the hours of 7 o'clock A. M. and five o'clock P. M. week days, and to handle and direct the work until the completion of the same subject to revision in the terms of this paragraph by the mutual consent of the parties hereto.

Party of the second part further agrees to save and keep harmless the party of the first part from any and all damage which may arise in the construction of the said floor.

All premium fees liability insurance to be considered as part of the labor cost and upon poper evidence of payment by the second party the same shall be reimbursed to the second party by the first party.
