RESOLVED, that whereas upon report duly filed it appears that Drainage District No 1 will require an assessment against the property benefit therein of \$1600.00, and whereas, that there is at this time cash to the credit of the maintenance fund of the said District the sum of \$1431.86.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that for this fiscal year no assessment be made against this district for maintenance and that the said sum of \$1431.86 be and the same is hereby appropriated for maintenance purposes in said District.

We offer for the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars, each, to take charge of the body, provide coffin, grave in cemetery, and pay all expenses of burial in the grounds we have purchased in which to bury all unclaimed dead.

We agree in each instance, to make a earnest effort to locate the relatives of the deceased and persuade them, if found, to pay the burial expenses.

We are frequently able to save Counties with whom we have contracts, the expenses of the burial of the bodies, and will attempt to do so in all instances.
