The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma Met in a regular session on the 19th Day of January, 1920, in the Commissioners' Room of the Tulsa County Court House in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Present: F. M. Wooden, Chairman, W. L. North, Vice-Chairman, Ed Dalton, Member, and Lewis Cline, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board. The auditing and allowing of the claims both General and Township were first taken up, after which the usual routine of Business.

RESOLUTION FOR THE SALE OF UNUSED PUBLIC
GROUNDS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

Whereas, Tulsa County, Oklahoma is the owner of and in possession of the following described real estate used as a county farm in said County and state and described as follows to-wit:

That part of the S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of section 32, Township 20 North, Range 13 east, described as follows to-wit: Beginning at the center of said section and running thence west a distance of 954.7 feet more or less to an intersection with the southerly right-of-way of the St. L. and SF Ry; thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line to an intersection with the north and south center line of said section 32; thence south a distance of 406 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning and containing 4.449/1000 acres, more or less,

Also:

That part of the North 1/2 of the SW quarter of section 32, township 20 North, Range 13 east described as beginning at a point 1051.25 feet east, and 340 feet north of the SW corner of said N 1/2 of SW 1/4 and running thence west 150 feet thence north, 608.68 feet more or less to the southerly right-of-way of the St. L. & SF Ry; thence North 66 degrees and 44 minutes east along said right-of-way line a distance of 163.2 feet; thence south a distance of 672.65 feet more or less to the point of beginning and containing 2.2 acres more or less.

Whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in a regular special adjourned meeting of the said Board held in the Commissioners' room in the Tulsa County Court House in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 5th day of January, 1920, has taken evidence and has been fully advised in the premises, finds and hereby adopts this resolution, declaring that the above described real estate is not needed for courthouse or jail purposes of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and is unsuitable for County Farm purposes and that other and more suitable real estate property within the said county is obtainable at a fair and reasonable value for the use of a County Poor Farm.

It is therefore, by this Board of County Commissioners Ordered that this resolution be published in full with the other proceedings of this meeting in the official paper of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and;

Be it further ordered that the Honorable Lewis Cline, County Clerk, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to forthwith certify a copy of this resolution to the Judge of the District Court.
