Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the following Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted, to-wit:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the people of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, have voted bonds in the amount of \$650,000.00, to be used for the purpose of building a separate school in Tulsa County; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Board of County Commissioners to construct buildings for separate schools and to acquire the necessary sites therefor; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of various sites for the proposed building the Board of County Commissioners has determined that the best suited site available for the purpose is a tract of land described as follows:

The Northeast Quarter (NE) of the Southeast Quarter (SE) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty North (20N), Range Thirteen East (13E), consisting of ten acres.

and a contiguous tract of land described as follows:

All of Blocks Three (3) and Four (4), in Coots Addition to the City of Tulsa, and

All of Blocks One (1), and Two (2), in Carver Heights Third Addition to the City of Tulsa, containing ten acres.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the acquisition of the above described property is necessary as a site for the proposed separate school building, and it is hereby declared to be necessary.
