The petition of Mrs. Olcer Colvert for Widow's pension was approved; also, the report of E. R. Stewart, Superintendent of the County Home was filed and approved.

In the matter of the application of the Public Service Company of Oklahoma to use certain Highways of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, the following order was made by the Board.

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"ORDER"

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA: That, Pursuant to the petition and request of the Public Service Company of Oklahoma, consent is hereby granted to said corporation to erect poles and posts and sustain wires and fixtures thereon, along the roads and highways hereinafter described, for the purpose of transporting electric current and energy between the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the town of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma. The highways to which this consent shall apply are described as follows to-wit:-

All the Public Highway immediately north of Section 24, Township 19 north, range 12 east, and sections 19 and 20 township 19 north, Range 13 east; thence along the highway east of sections 20 and 29, township 19 north, range 13 east; thence east along the right-of-way immediately north of section 33, 34 and 35, township 19 north, range 13 east; thence south along the public highway immediately east of section 35, township 19 north, range 13 east, and
