Section 2, township 18 north, range 13  
East; thence east along the public high-  
way immediately north of section 12, town-  
ship 18 north range 13 east, and sections  
7, 8, 9, 10, and 11, township 18 north,  
range 14 east, into Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

Provided, that the poles, wires and equipment shall be erected, placed  
adjusted, constructed and maintained so as not to incommode or endanger the  
public in the use of said roads, highways and thoroughfares; and provided further  
that nothing herein contained shall be construed to abridge or effect the  
rights, of abutting property owners along said highways; and provided further  
that the work shall be done under the supervision of the County Engineer; that  
the company will hold the County of Tulsa for any loss or damage due to the  
erection and maintaining of such pole line on the highway, and that the work  
for constructing said pole line shall be commenced within ninety days from the  
date of the granting of this application.

A petition was filed by the Tidal Oil Company seeking permission to  
construct on the north side of the bridge across the Arkansas River at Jenks  
in Tulsa County, sufficient cross arms and necessary braces to support the  
insulated wires carrying four hundred volts alternating current for the pur-  
pose of operating oil well on the west bank of the river by electric cur-  
rent from the power plant of the company situate on the east side of the  
river bed. Upon due consideration of the petition filed the following order  
was made by the Board.

"ORDER"

Now, on this 2nd day of February, 1920, Tidal Oil Company having filed  
a petition before this Board; and this board being fully advised in the premises  
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permission be and it is hereby granted to the said  
Tidal Oil Company to construct said cross arms and necessary braces as request-  
ed in said petition, it being understood that the construction thereof shall  
be done in such manner as will meet with the approval of the County Engineer  
of Tulsa County, and that the said Tidal Oil Company shall and does protect  
and hold harmless the County of Tulsa from any and all liability on account  
of any damages that may accrue by reason of the constructing of said cross  
arms and braces and the operation of said wells.

ELM CREEK BRIDGE.

This being the date set for the awarding of the contract of the Elm  
creek bridge, crossing the line between Section 28 and 33, township 21 north,  
Range 14 East, about one and one-half miles east of the town of Owasso, said  
bids were opened and upon motion of W. L. North, which motion was duly seconded  
by Ed Dalton, the contract for the construction of said bridge was awarded  
Joseph T. Lantry. Said Contractor to file contract and bond with the Board  
of County Commissioners. Twenty Three (\$23.00) Dollars Per cubic yard for  
concrete in place in the completed structure, and in lieu of the County of  
Tulsa furnishing the steel, seven cents (.07) for placing same. Said motion  
prevailed.

Upon motion of W. L. North, which motion was seconded by Ed Dalton,  
the contract for the construction of the 60 foot bridge over Mingo creek  
between sections 12 and 13, township 19 north, range 13 east, was awarded  
the Concrete and Steel Construction Company of Joplin, Missouri at \$22.90  
per cubic yard for concrete in place; reinforcing steel in abutments and  
wings at unit price of Seven Cents (.07) per pound in place; sixty (60) foot  
steel span completed and in place at sum price of \$2800.00 (Twenty Eight  
Hundred Dollars); concrete floor in place at Twenty three (\$ 23.00) Dollars  
per cubic yard and reinforcing steel in floor at seven cents (7) per pound  
in place. All members present voting in the affirmative and the motion was  
by the Chairman declared duly carried. Said contractor to file good and suf-  
ficient bond and contract with the Board of County Commissioners.

Upon motion of W. L. North seconded by F. M. Wooden the contract for  
the construction of a bridge over Joe Creek between sections 31 and 6, town-  
ship 18-19 North, range 13 east was awarded Joseph T. Lantry, with the inst-  
ruction that the County Engineer shall use his own discretion regarding the  
plans for the construction of this bridge.
