Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the resignation of Walter Hicks, who has been serving as night jailer, be and is hereby accepted as of May 1, 1946; and that Tom Bowlin be and hereby is appointed Deputy Sheriff to act as night jailer at a salary of \$175.00 per month, effective May 1, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Water Improvement District No. 5, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the period from December 31, 1945 to March 31, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
