The following affidavits of Erroneous Assessment were filed with and considered by the Board of County Commissioners, and by them ordered Stricken From Record; E. E. Cooper, Guardian of Florence and Stella Cooper, E. W. Woods, Mrs. B. F. Pinson, and C. J. Bullers.

In regard to case No. 10487, in the District Court, styled, Remington Typewriter Company, a corporation, Plaintiff -vs- The Board of County Commissioners, of Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, defendant, in action to recover the sum of \$529.90, for typewriter paper furnished by the plaintiff the Stenographers of the District, Superior and County Courts, a judgment was had against the defendant, Board of County Commissioners. The matter was referred to the office of the County Attorney for an opinion as to the advisability of appealing said case, and upon a report from that office, a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that said case be not appealed. All members voting in the affirmative.

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by W. L. North that the County Engineer, Dan W. Patton, be instructed to proceed immediately to cut a ditch along the East line of Section Thirteen (13) Township Nineteen (19), range Eleven (11) from the state road to the Arkansas River, to take care of the surplus water from the Sand Springs, Lake.

The resignation of John McBride as township road supervisor of Dawson township was filed with and approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that all of the bids on the one acre tract of land in Section 31, Township eighteen (18) north, Range Thirteen (13) east be rejected, and that the checks accompanying said bids be returned to their respective bidders. Motion prevailed.

Bids were received on the construction of the Skiatook-Collinsville State Highway. The contractors bidding were: T. C. Ottinger, Anadarko, Oklahoma, Froebe Briscoe Construction Company, Muskogee, Oklahoma J. E. Collins, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and McBride and Lowry, Tulsa, Oklahoma. The bids were opened and considered by the Board, and upon final consideration, a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the contract be awarded McBride and Lowry, the low bidder. A motion was made and duly seconded that all other checks be returned to the respective bidders, and that the contractor to whom the award was made, Vix., McBride and Lowry, be required to file a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of duties under said contract.
