RESOLUTION CONCURRING IN PROPOSED AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR
OKLAHOMA FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION
(FARM TO MARKET ROADS) AND AUTHORIZING USE OF FUNDS

Be it remembered that at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held at the Court House in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 11 day of March, 1946, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by said Board of County Commissioners, to-wit:

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of April, 1946, the Highway Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma proposed awarding a contract, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, for the construction of Oklahoma Federal Aid Secondary Project No. S-318(1), said project to be constructed under plans and specifications approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, on the 11th day of March, 1946, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the lowest and best bid at a letting held in the Capitol Office Building at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on the 23rd day of April, 1946, on said project in the estimated amount of \$17,145.97, was submitted by; Standard Paving Co.

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of County Commissioners concur in the proposed award of a contract for the construction of Oklahoma Federal Aid Secondary Project No. S-318(1) to the low bidder: Standard Paving Company.
