"ORDER VACATING A PART OF EASTLAND STREET;
TRIMBLE SUB-DIVISION.

The County Commissioners in session April 5th, 1920, orders and declares that party of Eastland Street of the Trimble Sub-division, conforming to the following description vacated; such portion to be vacated described as follows, to wit:

All that party of Eastland Street lying West of a line described as beginning at a point three hundred Forty (340) feet south and Five Hundred Six (506) feet east of the northwest corner of Section Eight (8), township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East and running thence north Eighteen (18) degrees and twenty Six (26) minutes East a distance of thirty one (31) and sixty two hundredths (31.62) feet; thence north and parallel to the West Line of eastland street and a distance of ten (10) feet therefrom to an inter-
