

And now on this day, same being a regular meeting of the Board, had and held after the expiration of ten days from the period of said publication notice of the sale of said property as provided by law, and the sealed bids for the sale thereof being now opened by the Board of County Commissioners in session duly assembled, and it appearing therefrom that the bid of Oscar J. Berendin the sum of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars is the highest and best bid for said property, and the same being more than ninety per cent of the appraised value thereof, and the Board being of the opinion that said bid is all that said property is reasonable worth, and that the same should be sold to said bidder;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that said property above described be and the same is hereby declared and ordered sold and struck off to the said Oscar J. Berend, for the consideration of the sum of three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars, and the said F. M. Wooden, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed to the said Oscar J. Berend for the consideration aforesaid, in the name of the County of Tulsa, for and on behalf of the County Commissioners of said county, to the purchaser, thereby conveying to him the above described property.
