MONDAY, JUNE 10, 1946

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M. with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the appointment of Marion J. Blake as Assistant County Attorney, succeeding Frank Leslie, who resigned, effective June 10, 1946, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that upon the recommendation of Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, and the County Attorney's Office, the following affidavits of erroneous assessment be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue Certificates of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Commissioner Gray, AYE; Commissioner Greer, NAY; Commissioner Bailey, "AYE. Chairman declared motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Petition filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, asking the creation of Tulsa County Drainage District #13, be and the same is hereby ordered published. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Petition to organize a Water Improvement District, filed by Ruth Messamore and others, be received and a hearing thereon be set before the Commission June 24, 1946, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M.; further, that cost bond submitted by C. R. Miller, and others, be received and approved, and the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be and hereby is directed to endorse approval thereon. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
