Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that Layman Construction Company, who is the low Bidder on Project 1-A covering the surfacing and improving of 46th Street North from Cincinnati Avenue to Lewis Avenue, a distance of 1.967 miles, be awarded the contract. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the Standard Paving Company, who is the low Bidder on Project 2-B, which covers the North Sand Springs Road from Bruner Hill to McKinley Avenue, Sand Springs, a distance of 3.658 miles, be awarded the contract, Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.


Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Proposals and Plans for the Surfacing and Improving of 56th Street North from Peoria Avenue to Lewis Avenue, Lewis Avenue from 56th Street North to 66th Street North, 66th Street North from Lewis Avenue to Peoria Avenue, a distance of 2.829 miles (the Engineer's estimate on the Project is \$52,793.80, be and the same is hereby approved, and the County Clerk is authorized to advertise for bids to be received until 9:00 o'clock A. M. June 17, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Project No. 1-B.



June 17, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Project No. 1-C.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Proposals and Plans for the surfacing and improving of 21st Street from Yale Avenue to Memorial Drive, a distance of 2.004 miles (the Engineer's Estimate on the Project is \$43,074.10), be and the same is hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to advertise for bids to be received until 9:00 o'clock A. M. June 17, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Project No. 3-A.
