

MONDAY, JUNE 24, 1946

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Water Improvement District #3, Turley, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the period from March 19, 1946 to June 19, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the bond filed by E. V. Hendren, Justice of the Peace, Broken Arrow, in the amount of \$1,000 and made by the Western Surety Company, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that upon the recommendation of Joe Parkinson, County Treasurer, Quit Claim Deeds to A. R. Martin covering the North 20' of Lot 1, Block 5, West Tulsa Addition to the City of Tulsa, and one to the heirs and devisees of S. L. Shields, Deceased, covering Lot 1, in Block 7, Summit Heights Addition to the City of Tulsa be and the same are hereby approved, and the Chairman be authorized to execute same. These deeds are given to correct error in deeding said properties to the County. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of Paul Shimp, County Highway Department employe in District #3, as of July 1, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the resignation of Jesse Tabor, Bridge Inspector, County Highway Department, District #2, as of July 1, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
