Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M. with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Purchase Order #23800 covering the purchase of one Chevrolet Chassis SSB CH Model 4502; Model 56020 E, Wayne Body R0038 Heater, deluxe, installed in the amount of \$2,783.61, from the Bixby Motor Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the report file by W. K. Gray, Secretary-Manager, Tulsa State Fair, for the month of May, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Contracts and Bonds with Layman and Company, Tulsa, on Project 1-C, covering surfacing and improving of Cincinnati Avenue from Mohawk Blvd. to 46th Street North, a distance of 2.062 miles, be and the same are hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Contracts and Bonds with Layman and Company, Tulsa, covering the surfacing and improving of 21st Street from Yale Avenue to Memorial Drive, a distance of 2.004 miles, be and the same are hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the proposals and plans and specifications for surfacing and improving Wekiwa Road from Euchee Creek to Shell Creek, a distance of 1.212 miles, be approved and the County Clerk be and hereby is authorized to advertise for Bids to be received until 9:00 o'clock A. M. Monday, July 8, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Project 2-C.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the plans and specifications on Project 1-B, covering the surfacing and improving of 56th St. North, Lewis Avenue and 66th St. North, from Feoria Avenue and 56th Street North to Lewis Avenue, a distance of 2.829 miles, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to advertise for Bids to be received until 9:00 o'clock A. M. Monday, July 8, 1946. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
