In order to receive, and make these medications available without delay, the Board of County Commissioner is holding this emergency meeting, to discuss and vote on a contract with the State Department of Health."

Moved by Perry, seconded by Jordan to approve and authorize execution by the Chairman, the request from Social Services, for the contract with Oklahoma State Department of Health, to allow health care providers and pharmacists, licensed in Oklahoma, to request free antivirals purchased by the Federal government, for use in persons without third-party payer coverage for antivirals.
