Doug Wilson, Assistant District Attorney Civil Division Director, advised the Commissioners to not take action and to schedule an emergency meeting. An emergency meeting will be scheduled for later today, March 27, 2020, at 11:15 a.m. for discussion and possible action concerning issues related to the COVID-19 Virus.
